## The Massachusetts Gaming Commission to Hold 'Host Community' Public Hearing for MGM Springfield Proposal

Public input meetings offer opportunity for community members to directly provide the Commission feedback on resort-casino proposals

WHO: Members of the Massachusetts Gaming Commission, representatives from resort-casino applicant MGM Springfield and members of the public

WHAT: The Massachusetts Gaming Commission will hold a 'host community' public hearing in Springfield, MA as a means to facilitate public discussion regarding the recently submitted MGM Springfield Category 1 or resort-casino application. This public hearing is in addition to meetings held by the Commission in neighboring communities to the proposal. The purpose of these meetings is to provide members of the public with an additional opportunity to address the resort-casinos applicants and the Commission. The meetings will also serve as a vehicle at which the community can receive updates from applicants on their resort-casino proposals and mitigation strategies. No vote or decisions will be made at these hearings; they are opportunities for the Commission to gather information and gauge public sentiment relative to the applications.
