The Massachusetts Gaming Commission to Hold 'Host Community' Public Hearings on Resort-Casino Gaming Applications

WHAT: The Massachusetts Gaming Commission will host two 'host

> community' public hearings as a means to facilitate public discussion regarding the submitted Category 1 or resort-casino applications in Region A (Eastern Massachusetts). These public hearings are continuations of the Commission's June 24 and June 25, 2014 hearings and are intended to provide the Commission with a final opportunity to hear comments from the public relating to events that have transpired since the opening of the hearings. The meetings will also serve as a vehicle at which the community can receive updates from applicants on their resort-casino proposals and mitigation strategies. No votes or decisions will be made at these hearings; they are opportunities for the Commission to gather information and gauge public sentiment relative to the applications prior to the deliberation. and award evaluation. of the Eastern Massachusetts license.
