#### **Massachusetts Gaming Commission to Hold Open Public Meeting**

**WHAT:** The Massachusetts Gaming Commission will hold its 141<sup>st</sup> open public meeting on Thursday, December 18<sup>th</sup>. The Commission is expected to discuss and vote on a variety of topics.

The Commission will receive a presentation on the recent Central Management System procurement.

Also, the Commission will discuss findings regarding the environmental impacts and the implementation of mitigation strategies at Plainridge Park Casino in Plainville. The Commission is also expected to vote on the Community Mitigation Fund application and process.

Additionally, the Commission will be briefed on a number of legal matters including a Department of Revenue request for interpretation of reporting and tax thresholds.

The Director of Research and Responsible Gaming, Mark Vander Linden, will present on a variety of subjects to include a presentation on a responsible gaming branding initiative known as 'GameSense'. Lastly, the Commission is expected to vote on revised play management and research agenda recommendations.
