## Massachusetts Gaming Commission to Hold Open Public Meeting in Springfield

WHAT: The Massachusetts Gaming Commission will hold its 146<sup>th</sup> open public meeting on

Thursday, March 5<sup>th</sup>.

In observance of National Problem Gambling Awareness Month, the Commission will discuss screening, diagnosis, and resources for those with a gambling disorder. The Commission will also hear a presentation from the Cambridge Health Alliance about the upcoming Gambling Disorder Screening Day, which will be observed on March 10<sup>th</sup>.

Additionally, Commissioners will receive an update on MGM Springfield's progress to date and future construction timeline.

Commissioners will discuss requests received from communities seeking monies from the 2015 Mitigation Reserve Fund. The Commission will also discuss requests for funding from the Race Horse Development Fund.

Lastly, the Commission is expected to vote on draft regulations regarding gross gaming revenue taxes and financial reporting.
