## **Massachusetts Gaming Commission to Hold Open Public Meeting**

Topics include Wynn Boston Harbor and Plainridge Park Casino Quarterly Reports, Community Mitigation Grant and Regulations

WHAT: The Massachusetts Gaming Commission (MGC) will hold its 198<sup>th</sup> open

public meeting on Thursday, August 18, 2016.

Wynn Boston Harbor and Plainridge Park Casino will present Quarterly Reports to the Commission.

The Commission is expected to vote on a Community Mitigation Grant for Springfield. The Commission is also expected to vote on a recommendation from the Horse Racing Committee on whether the Race Horse Development Fund split should be retroactive to January 1, 2016.

Lastly, the Commission is expected to vote on a series of regulations regarding the licensing and registration of casino employees and slot machine equipment.
