The Massachusetts Gaming Commission to hold Public Meeting in Everett

Topics include Wynn Boston Harbor Quarterly Report and GameSense Evaluation Report

WHO: Members of the *Massachusetts Gaming Commission* including **Chairman Steve Crosby, Commissioner Lloyd Macdonald, Commissioner Bruce Stebbins and Commissioner Enrique Zuniga; City of Everett Mayor Carlo DiMaria** and representatives from *Wynn Boston Harbor*

WHAT: The Massachusetts Gaming Commission (MGC) will hold its 202nd open public meeting on **WEDNESDAY, October 26, 2016.**

The Commission will hold this public meeting in the City of Everett and Mayor Carlo DiMaria is scheduled to provide opening remarks.

Researchers from the Cambridge Health Alliance/Division on Addiction will present commissioners with an analysis and evaluation of MGC's responsible gaming program GameSense.

Representatives from Wynn Boston Harbor will present a quarterly report and seek Commission approval on design. The Commission will also have a follow-up discussion about the number of Wynn's slot machines and gaming positions.

Commissioners are expected to vote on Small Business Impact Statement- 205 CMR 134.00: Licensing and Registration of Employees, Vendors, Junket Enterprises and Representatives and Labor Organizations.
