The following is a summary of the major proposed updates to the RFA-2 application form:

- 1. Add new language to instructions: To the extent that anything contained in this application is inconsistent with any other guidance or policy related document issued by the Commission in the past, this application shall control. To the extent that anything contained in this application is inconsistent with any provision of 205 CMR or G.L. c.23K, the governing law shall control.
- 2. Update the instructions for filling out the application to further clarify that no inference shall be drawn from the number of spaces provided for specifying attachments relative to the number of attachments that the Commission is actually seeking.
- 3. Clarify instructions relative to filling out summary boxes explaining that applicants must provide a summary of its attached response to the question posed, containing certain pieces of specified information, that will be provided in response to any public record request (while the attachment itself may not be). Further, clarification will be made to the public records section explaining that an applicant should mark each attachment that it believes to contain confidential information "confidential." The Commission would anticipate the public release of the entire 200 plus page unredacted application; it will then review the attachments and confidentiality requests for further release.

 Identify and discuss the diversity within the leadership and ownership of the applicant, if any.
- 8. Change title of section 2 from 'Financial' to 'Finance.'
- 9. Inserted language to the 2-10 Timeline for Construction to comply with 205 CMR 119.01(27): "Include the deadline by which the stages and overall construction and any infrastructure improvements will be completed, and a projected date that the applicant will begin gaming operations."
- 10. Clarify 2-25 (and compare with 2-27):

Provide a history of meeting-operating performance versus revenue projections over the last ten years with respect to each facility of a size comparable to or larger than the facility you are proposing for Massachusetts.
