Call to Order

10:00 a.m. Commissioner Crosby called to order the 17th Agenda Setting meeting.

Approval of Minutes

Commissioner Macdonald moved to approve the minutes of the Agenda Setting meeting on August 2, 2017. Motion seconded by Commissioner Stebbins. Commissioner Cameron and Commissioner Stebbins abstained. Motion passed 3-0.

Agenda Planning for Upcoming Commission Meetings

(Potential Commission Meeting on 9/14/17)

 $\underline{\text{Item } #1 - \text{Administrative Update}}. \quad \text{Executive Director Bedrosian will do an administrative update}.$

<u>Item #2 – Review MGC Mission and Values</u>. Executive Director Bedrosian reported that this item is ready to go.

Item #3 – <u>Review MGC Enhanced Code of Ethics</u>. Executive Director Bedrosian reported that this item is ready to go.

<u>Item #4 – Vendor Diversity Exemption Process</u>. Director Jill Griffin reported that this item is ready to go and will require a vote.

<u>Item #5 – Hearing Process Regulations Discussion</u>. Executive Director Bedrosian reported that this item is ready to go.

<u>Item #6 – Region C Gaming School Funding Update¹</u>. Director Griffin reported that the community college presidents will come in for this item and she would like this to be moved to an early spot on the agenda if possible. The purpose of this is to discuss funding for the gaming school in western Massachusetts

<u>Item #7 – Analysis of Authority to Issue Fines.</u> General Counsel Blue reported that this item is ready to go. No commission action is required on this item.

<u>Item #8 – GPAC (Gaming Policy Advisory Committee) Reappointments</u>. Ombudsman Ziemba Reported that no GPAC meeting is scheduled at this time and that this item can be moved out if necessary.

<u>Item #9 – Licensee Quarterly Report</u>. Ombudsman Ziemba reported that Plainridge Park Casino will be ready to present their quarterly report.

<u>Item #10 – NEHBPA Request for Funds</u>. Racing Director Lightbown reports that if she receives the requested audit by Monday, September 11 this item will be ready to go on September 14. Otherwise, she will ask to remove it from the September 14 agenda.

Item #11 - 2018 Mitigation Fund Guidelines. Ombudsman Ziemba reported that this item begins the process of review of the guidelines for next year's community mitigation fund program. Ombudsman Ziemba will be requesting advice on the guidelines and will provide the Commission with a schedule of meetings on the guidelines.

Item #12 – Suffolk Downs Request for Purse Funding from the Race Horse Development Fund. Racing Director Lightbown reported that Suffolk Downs held more races than expected on its last weekend of racing and will be requesting additional purse money from the Race Horse Development Fund to cover the additional races. There was a discussion on whether this should be moved to the September 28 Commission meeting and it was decided to leave this item on the agenda for September 14. This item requires a vote.

<u>Item #13 – Northampton Mitigation Fund Reserve Request.</u> Ombudsman Ziemba reported that this item is ready to go. This item requires a vote.

Additional Items:

<u>Economic Development Fund Update.</u> Commissioner Stebbins asked that this item be added so that he can update the Commission on his work regarding the Economic Development Fund recommendations.

Amendment to the Medford Community Mitigation Fund Grant.

Ombudsman Ziemba asked that this item be added to request Commission approval Of Medford's request to amend the scope of work included in its Community Mitigation Fund Grant Agreement. This item requires a vote.

<u>Recommendation on Play My Way.</u> Director Vander Linden asked that this item be added to the September 14 agenda. This item requires a vote.

<u>Approval of Capital Improvement Funds for Suffolk Downs and Plainridge Park Casino.</u> Racing Director Lightbown asked that this be added to the agenda for September 14 and that this item will require a vote.

Update on the Legislative Amendment Regarding Gaming

<u>Service Employees.</u> Chairman Crosby requested that the Commissioner Update section of the September 14 agenda include an update on activity regarding the legislative change regarding Gaming service employees and the requirement to register and undergo a background check.

Appointment of Commissioner to Testify at the Upcoming Racing Hearing. The Chairman asked that this item be added to allow the Commission to discuss the appointment of a commissioner to testify at the September 19 hearing before the Joint Committee on Consumer Protection and Professional Licensure on HB 9, An Act Relative to Horse Racing and Wagering which was filed by the Commission. This will require a vote. Executive Director Bedrosian asked whether a report on winners of purses at Suffolk Downs could be generated before the hearing. Racing Director Lightbown indicated that we will not have this information by the time of the hearing but will receive this information after the meet is completed.

(Potential Commission Meeting on 9/28/17)

Item #14 – Plainridge Park Casino Operation, Economic Impact Report. Director Vander Linden said that this item will be ready to go and will take About 45 minutes. Director Vander Linden also requested that item #24, Updated General Population Survey will also be ready for the September 28 agenda and it will need about 15 minutes.

<u>Item #15 – LMS Update</u>. Director Connolly reported that this item will be ready for the October 12 meeting.

<u>Item #16 – Five Year Look Back</u>. Commissioner Zuniga asked that this item be moved to the October 12 meeting.

<u>Item #17 – MGM Springfield Status Update</u>. Ombudsman Ziemba reported that this item Ready for the September 28 meeting and will need approximately 2 hours.

Ombudsman Ziemba stated that the Penn quarterly report should be moved to November.
