



Notice of Public Hearing

Notice is hereby provided that in accordance with G.L. c.30A, §2, the Massachusetts Gaming Commission (“Commission”) will convene a public hearing for purposes of gathering comments, ideas, and information relative to proposed amendments and the addition of new sections to 205 CMR. The proposals were developed pursuant to G.L. c.23K, §5(a) as part of the Commission’s regulation promulgation process. The proposals include the following amendments and new sections:

205 CMR 101: M.G.L. c. 23K Adjudicatory Proceedings - New regulations governing the adjudicatory proceedings of the Commission.

205 CMR 136: Sale and Distribution of Alcoholic Beverages at Gaming Establishments – New regulations governing the sale and distribution of alcoholic beverages at gaming establishments.

205 CMR 150: Protection of Minors & Underage Youth - New regulations governing the protection of minors and underage youth at gaming establishments.

205 CMR 151: Operations and Conduct of Gaming at a Gaming Establishment - New regulations governing the requirements that a gaming establishment has to satisfy before the Commission issues an Operation Certificate.

205 CMR 152: Individuals Excluded from a Gaming Establishment: New regulations governing the requirements for the exclusion of individuals from Gaming Establishments. In addition, elected officials of a host community in which a gaming establishment is located shall not place a wager in that gaming establishment. This regulation does not bar an elected official from being present in the gaming establishment.
