COMMISSIONER STEBBINS: Good

morning, today is Thursday, April 23, 2015.

This is a public hearing before the
Massachusetts Gaming Commission. I am Bruce
Stebbins, a Commissioner with the Gaming
Commission.

This hearing is being convened
pursuant to Mass. General Law Chapter 30A
section 2 and Mass. General Law Chapter 23K
section 5. Before we begin, the Commission
would like to thank all of you for being here
today.

This is a public hearing. It is
critically important that you the public be part
of our rulemaking process to ensure that the
Commission achieves the best results possible.
The purpose of this public hearing is to offer
any interested person or group an opportunity to
comment on the Commission's regulations.

This is not a question-and-answer
period or a debate. Once we begin, anybody who
wishes to comment on the proposals may raise

1 their hand and be recognized by the Commission.
2 They may then proceed to offer their comments.

3 There are two sets of regulations on
4 the agenda for today. They are 205 CMR 139
5 Continuing Disclosure and Reporting Obligations
6 of Gaming Licensees. These regulations set
7 forth the requirements and procedures for
8 continued disclosure and reporting by the gaming
9 licensees.

10 There's also 205 CMR 140, which is
11 Gross Gaming Revenue Tax Remittance and
12 Reporting. These regulations govern the
13 requirements for tax reporting and payments by a
14 gaming establishment.

15 These are the proposals that we will
16 now hear comments on. The Commission requests
17 that all speakers please identify themselves
18 prior to commenting. Also please be sure to
19 keep your voices up as this hearing is being
20 recorded. With that, we will now open the floor
21 for comment.

22 I will adjourn this hearing until we
23 have any members of the public arrive seeking to
24 make comment.
