12	Two proposals on the agenda for comment
13	today. The first involves changes to 205 CMR 4.00
14	primarily pertaining to safety practices for the
15	participants involved in horse racing. The second
16	is a change to 205 CMR 6.00 pertaining to the minimum
17	payout in the event of a minimum pool.

DURENBERGER: Commissioner, I 15 would just like to add that we have received no 16 public comment. We have had request for public 17 comment on the website for a period of about three 18 weeks.
