This hearing today is being convened pursuant to the Massachusetts General Law Chapter 30A, Section 2, and Massachusetts General Law Chapter 23K, Section 5.

Before we begin, I'd like to thank you all for being here today. This is a public hearing, and it is critically important that you, the public, be a part of our rule-making process to ensure that the Commission achieves the best results possible. The purpose of this public hearing is to offer any interested person or group an opportunity to comment on the Commission's regulations. It is not a question-and-answer period or debate. Once we begin, anybody who wishes to comment on the proposals may raise

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their hand and be recognized by the Commission. They may then proceed to offer the comment.

The following regulations are on the agenda for today. Those are 205 CMR 138 known as Uniform Standards of Accounting Procedures and Internal Controls. These amendments create a requirement for gaming licensees to use reasonable measures to inhibit patrons from using credit to obtain cash for use at a gaming establishment. Three such measures are explicitly required by the amendments. Additionally, these amendments clarify the language of the regulation to address the uncertainty as to the meaning of the, quote, "cash advance."

This is the proposal that we will now hear comments on. The Commission requests that all speakers please identify themselves prior to commenting. Also, please be sure to keep your voices up as this hearing is being recorded. With that, we will now open up the floor for comment.
