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4	CHAIRMAN CROSBY: I would like to call to
5	order public meeting number 17, which is to be held today
6	at 3:00. This was an opportunity for people to make
7	comments on the transition of our racing regs from
8	emergency to permanent. Do we have anybody here who
9	wants to comment? Okay.
10	Do we have to stay open until 4:00?
11	COMMISSIONER MCHUGH: We do.
12	CHAIRMAN CROSBY: So, what we are going to
13	do is suspend this meeting. If anybody comes in who does
14	want to speak up, we will go back to the meeting.
15	Meanwhile, we will suspend this meeting number 17 and go
16	back to meeting number 16.
17	MS. COOK: Chairman, Nina Pickering-Cook
18	of Anderson and Kreiger. I was wondering if the
19	Commission got any written comments on the regulations?
20	COMMISSIONER MCHUGH: The Commission
21	received no written comments on the regulations.
22	MS. COOK: Thank you.
23	CHAIRMAN CROSBY: If only all of our life
24	were as easy as this.
25	So, we have a motion to suspend meeting 17

1 and return to meeting 16. COMMISSIONER MCHUGH: So moved. 2 CHAIRMAN CROSBY: Second? 3 COMMISSIONER CAMERON: Second. 4 CHAIRMAN CROSBY: All in favor, aye. 5 COMMISSIONER ZUNIGA: 6 Aye. 7 COMMISSIONER CAMERON: Ave. 8 COMMISSIONER STEBBINS: Aye. 9 COMMISSIONER MCHUGH: Aye. 10 CHAIRMAN CROSBY: We are now in suspension on 17 and back to 16. 11 12 13 (Meeting suspended) 14 15 COMMISSIONER MCHUGH: I am going to reconvene meeting number 17, which was and is being held 16 17 to seek public comment on the permanent regulations that 18 will support the Gaming Commission's takeover of the 19 functions formerly performed at the State Racing 20 Commission, and keep those regulations in place the rest 21 of the year. 22 The presumption of meeting number 17 is 23 designed to allow anyone who is present and here to make comments about those proposed regulations and for the 24 25 Commission to consider those comments.

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1	Is there anyone here who wishes to make
2	comments about those regulations? I hear and see no
3	response. Therefore, having now concluded at 4:00 the
4	meeting that the Commission posted from 3:00 p.m. to 4:00
5	p.m. today, I am going to a move that we adopt those
б	regulations.
7	In order to do that, I am going to move that
8	the Gaming Commission promulgate the proposed regulation
9	205CMR 13:00 to provide for the orderly transition of the
10	regulation of horseracing, harness racing, pari-mutuel
11	wagering, simulcasting and the humane handling, care,
12	treatment and transportation of racing greyhounds and
13	related subject matter from the Massachusetts State
14	Racing Commission to the Massachusetts Gaming
15	Commission Strike that, please.
16	I am going to move that the Gaming
17	Commission issue an amended small-business impact
18	statement pursuant to General Laws 38 Section 5 regarding
19	the proposed 205CMR 13 in substantially the form that is
20	part of the packet that has been distributed to all of
21	you and to those here in the audience. And to authorize
22	Commissioner Cameron to take any action she may deem
23	appropriate to finalize and submit said statement to the
24	Secretary of the Commonwealth and propose to publish the
25	statement on the Commission's website and the

Massachusetts Register for the Secretary of the 1 Commonwealth or otherwise. 2 Do I hear a second to that motion? 3 COMMISSIONER STEBBINS: Second. 4 5 COMMISSIONER MCHUGH: All in favor, please say aye. б 7 COMMISSIONER ZUNIGA: Ave. COMMISSIONER CAMERON: 8 Aye. 9 COMMISSIONER STEBBINS: Aye. 10 COMMISSIONER MCHUGH: Now I return to the 11 other motion and move that the Gaming Commission 12 promulgate the proposed regulation 205CMR 13:00 to 13 provide for the orderly transition of the regulation of 14 horseracing, harness horseracing, pari-mutuel wagering, 15 simulcasting, and the humane handling, care, treatment 16 and transportation of racing greyhounds and related 17 subject matters from the Massachusetts State Racing 18 Commission to the Massachusetts Gaming Commission in 19 substantially the form, again, that has been distributed 20 to you and is part of the packets distributed to all in 21 attendance. And to authorize Commissioner Cameron to 22 take all necessary actions including without limitation 23 to filing the regulations with and making any corrections 24 as may be necessary to conform to the requirements of the 25 Massachusetts Secretary of the Commonwealth for proper

1	promulgation of these regulations.
2	Do I hear a second to that motion?
3	COMMISSIONER ZUNIGA: Second.
4	COMMISSIONER MCHUGH: All in favor, aye.
5	COMMISSIONER ZUNIGA: Aye.
6	COMMISSIONER CAMERON: Aye.
7	COMMISSIONER STEBBINS: Aye.
8	COMMISSIONER MCHUGH: That now concludes
9	the business of that meeting. I take it, Attorney Cook,
10	you will take the next steps necessary on our behalf have
11	to get these matters filed with the Secretary of State?
12	MS. COOK: I will in conjunction with
13	Commissioner Cameron.
14	COMMISSIONER MCHUGH: Thank you. That
15	concludes the business of meeting number 17. So, I would
16	entertain a motion to adjourn.
17	COMMISSIONER STEBBINS: So moved.
18	COMMISSIONER MCHUGH: Second?
19	COMMISSIONER CAMERON: Second.
20	COMMISSIONER MCHUGH: All in favor, aye.
21	COMMISSIONER ZUNIGA: Aye.
22	COMMISSIONER CAMERON: Aye.
23	COMMISSIONER STEBBINS: Aye.
24	COMMISSIONER MCHUGH: That meeting is
25	adjourned.
