Participation Goals Review

Consultant / Contractor Participation – Design Contracts:

Design: M/W/VBE Participation

- Design work is in progress, with many design areas yet to be awarded to consultants. The majority of the design work will be completed by the end of 2016.
- As of June 30th, 2015 Wynn has awarded:
 - <u>5.3% of design contracts to MBEs</u>, up from 5.2% awarded as of May 31st, a result of an existing MBE contract expanded in scope.
 - <u>1.3% of design contracts to WBEs</u>, up from 0.7% as of May 31st, with 2 interior design contracts awarded to Cleo Design, a WBE located in Las Vegas.
 - 0% of design contracts to VBEs.



Design: M/W/VBE Participation

• Wynn expects to achieve 5.7% MBE, 8.6% WBE, and 1% VBE participation over the next several months, following the award of contracts that are in progress.
