Massachusetts Gaming Commission to Hold Open Public Meeting

Topics include Open Meeting Law, Daily Fantasy Sports and Voluntary Self-Exclusion Regulations

- WHO: Members of the Massachusetts Gaming Commission including Chairman Steve Crosby, Commissioner Gayle Cameron, Commissioner Lloyd Macdonald, Commissioner Bruce Stebbins and Commissioner Enrique Zuniga
- **WHAT:** The Massachusetts Gaming Commission (MGC) will hold its 174th open public meeting on January, 7th. The Commission will have a discussion about recent correspondence received from the Office of the Attorney General regarding the Open Meeting Law. In addition, Chairman Crosby will provide a status update on the progress of the Daily Fantasy Sports white paper.

MGC's Research and Responsible Gaming Director Mark Vander Linden, in collaboration with legal staff, will lead a discussion about potential amendments to voluntary self-exclusion regulations.

The Commission is also expected to vote on key employee gaming license awards and the Plainridge Park Racecourse Capital Improvement Fund reimbursement request.
