WHAT: The Massachusetts Gaming Commission (MGC) will hold its 207<sup>th</sup> open public

The Commission will also vote to initiative the formal process for regulation 205 CMR 134 regarding licensing and registration of employees, vendors, junket enterprises, representative and labor organizations.

MGC's Director of Research and Responsible Gaming Mark Vander Linden will lead a discussion about a responsible gaming plan for Category 1 (resort-casino) licensees.
