The Massachusetts Gaming Commission to hold Public Meeting *Topics include MGC Enhanced Code of Ethics and Cohort Study Research Update*

- WHO: Members of the Massachusetts Gaming Commission including Chairman Steve Crosby, Commissioner Gayle Cameron, Commissioner Lloyd MacDonald, Commissioner Bruce Stebbins and Commissioner Enrique Zuniga
- **WHAT:** The Massachusetts Gaming Commission (MGC) will hold its 232nd open public meeting on **WEDNESDAY, JANUARY 10, 2018**.

The Commission will start the meeting with an administrative update to include a vote about MGC's Enhanced Code of Ethics.

Research and Responsible Gaming Director Mark Vander Linden will introduce an update about the Massachusetts Gaming Impact Cohort (MAGIC) Study. This is the first major cohort study of adult gambling to be carried out in the United States.

Lastly, the Legal Division will request a Commission vote in regards to a nondisclosure request from MGM Springfield.
