## **The Massachusetts Gaming Commission to hold Public Meeting in Springfield** *Topics include MGM Springfield Opening Preparations, City of Springfield, Economic Development Grants and Horse Racing*

**WHO:** Members of the *Massachusetts Gaming Commission* including **Chairman Steve Crosby, Commissioner Gayle Cameron, Commissioner Eileen O'Brien, Commissioner Bruce Stebbins** and **Commissioner Enrique Zuniga**

**WHAT:** The Massachusetts Gaming Commission (MGC) will hold its 241<sup>st</sup> open public meeting in Springfield on **THURSDAY, April 26, 2018**.

The public meeting will begin with an update from Executive Director Ed Bedrosian about regulatory preparations for the MGM Springfield opening. Springfield Chief Development Officer Kevin Kennedy will present the Commission with a status update on the city's ongoing economic development initiatives.

The Commission is expected to vote on both the designation of the MGM Springfield gaming floor and gaming establishment.

Jill Griffin, MGC's director of Workforce, Supplier and Diversity Development, will lead a discussion about economic development grant funding for the Hampden County Sheriff's Office and the Quabog Valley Community Development Corporation.

The Commission will vote on a purse funding request from Suffolk Downs.
