The Massachusetts Gaming Commission to hold Public Meeting

Topics include MGC Officer Election, Problem Gambling Awareness Month, MGM Springfield Residential Unit Requirement, and Horse Racing

WHAT: The Massachusetts Gaming Commission will hold public meeting #265 on **Thursday, March 28, 2019.**

The meeting will open with a general administrative update from Executive Director Ed Bedrosian and will include a Commission vote regarding the election of its officers.

MGC's Office of Research and Responsible Gaming will provide the Commission with an update about ongoing activities to support and promote Problem Gambling Awareness Month.
