The Massachusetts Gaming Commission Releases June 2019 Gross Gaming Revenue for Plainridge Park Casino, MGM Springfield and Encore Boston Harbor

The Massachusetts Gaming Commission reported today that the month of June 2019 at Plainridge Park Casino (PPC), MGM Springfield and Encore Boston Harbor (June 23 to June 30) generated approximately **\$50 million** in Gross Gaming Revenue (GGR). PPC, a category 2 slots facility, is taxed on 49% of GGR. Of that total taxed amount, 82% is paid to Local Aid and 18% is allotted to the Race Horse Development Fund. MGM Springfield and Encore Boston Harbor, category 1 resort-casinos, are taxed on 25% of GGR; those monies are [allocated to several specific state funds](#) as determined by the gaming statute.

To date, the Commonwealth has collected approximately **\$387 million** in total taxes and assessments from PPC, MGM and Encore Boston Harbor since the respective openings of each gaming facility.
