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The Massachusetts Gaming Commission Releases July 2020 Gross Gaming Revenue for Plainridge Park Casino, MGM Springfield and Encore Boston Harbor

The Massachusetts Gaming Commission reported today that **July 8-31, 2020** generated approximately **\$45 million** in Gross Gaming Revenue (GGR) at Plainridge Park Casino (PPC), MGM Springfield and Encore Boston Harbor. The results reported today reflect the GGR collected after casinos were permitted to reopen—with **COVID-19** related restrictions in place—in Phase 3 of the Commonwealth's phased reopening, which began July 6, 2020.

PPC, a category 2 slots facility, is taxed on 49% of GGR. Of that total taxed amount, 82% is paid to Local Aid and 18% is allotted to the Race Horse Development Fund. MGM Springfield and Encore Boston Harbor, category 1 resort-casinos, are taxed on 25% of GGR; those monies are allocated to several specific state funds as determined by the gaming statute.

To date, the Commonwealth has collected approximately **\$595 million** in total taxes and assessments from PPC, MGM and Encore since the respective openings of each gaming facility.
