The Massachusetts Gaming Commission Releases September 2020 Gross Gaming Revenue for Plainridge Park Casino, MGM Springfield and Encore Boston Harbor

The Massachusetts Gaming Commission reported today that the month of September 2020 at Plainridge Park Casino (PPC), MGM Springfield and Encore Boston Harbor generated approximately **\$70 million** in Gross Gaming Revenue (GGR). The results reported today reflect the second full month of GGR collected after casinos were permitted to reopen in Phase 3 of the Commonwealth's phased reopening. The three licensees collected 87% of gross gaming revenue on approximately 49 percent of the gaming positions available, as compared to September 2019.

PPC, a category 2 slots facility, is taxed on 49% of GGR. Of that total taxed amount, 82% is paid to Local Aid and 18% is allotted to the Race Horse Development Fund. MGM Springfield and Encore Boston Harbor, category 1 resort-casinos, are taxed on 25% of GGR; those monies are [allocated to several specific state funds](#) as determined by the gaming statute.

To date, the Commonwealth has collected approximately **\$635 million** in total taxes and assessments from PPC, MGM and Encore since the respective openings of each gaming facility.
