**WHAT:** The MGC will hold a public hearing on **Tuesday, January 3** at **10 am**.

The Massachusetts Gaming Commission will hold a public hearing Tuesday, January 3, regarding the six applications for untethered Category 3 Sports Wagering Licenses.

Tuesday's Public Hearing is meant to provide the public an opportunity to give comment(s) on the existing applications for untethered Category 3 Sports Wagering Licenses, which can be found on the Commission's website. Those wishing to speak at the hearing should email MGCcomments@massgaming.gov in advance to be placed on the list of speakers. Alternatively, written comments may also be submitted to the same email address with 'Category 3 - Untethered public comment' in the subject line. Written comments are preferred in advance of the hearing but will be accepted on a rolling basis by the Commission.

Six applications for untethered Category 3 licenses have been submitted to the Commission from: Bally's Interactive, LLC; Betfair Interactive US, LLC (d/b/a FanDuel); Betr Holdings, Inc.; Crown MA Gaming, LLC (d/b/a DraftKings); Digital Gaming Corporation USA; and PointsBet Massachusetts, LLC.

Meetings regarding those applications are expected to be held in the days and weeks following Tuesday's hearing. More information on those meeting dates, times and schedules is soon to follow.
