The Massachusetts Gaming Commission to hold Public Hearing at Plainville Town Hall

WHO: Members of the *Massachusetts Gaming Commission* including **Chair Jordan Maynard** and **Commissioners Paul Brodeur, Brad Hill, Eileen O'Brien, and Nakisha Skinner**

WHAT: The Massachusetts Gaming Commission will convene a **public hearing on Thursday, May 1, 2025**

The Massachusetts Gaming Commission will convene a public hearing at Plainville Town Hall to obtain public input regarding Plainville Gaming and Redevelopment, LLC (d/b/a Plainridge Park Casino)'s renewal of a Category 2 gaming license.

Once the hearing is called to order, there will be an opportunity for Plainville Gaming and Redevelopment to comment on the licensing renewal. Representatives of the host community, surrounding communities, and the impacted live entertainment venues will also be given an opportunity for public comment.

Following, there will be an opportunity for any other members of the public to comment. Please note that the Commission will limit each speaker to 5 minutes to use the available time efficiently. At the discretion of the Chair, comments may be taken from members of the public who have not pre-registered to speak at the end of the meeting.

The Commission will not vote or decide on a renewal at this hearing; it is intended to gather information and gauge public sentiment regarding the renewal application.
