Meeting Notification

The Massachusetts Gaming Commission to hold Public Meeting

Topics include: The FY26 Community Mitigation Fund, update on the Sports Wagering event catalog, and more.

WHO: Members of the *Massachusetts Gaming Commission* including **Chair Jordan Maynard** and **Commissioners Paul Brodeur, Brad Hill, Eileen O'Brien, and Nakisha Skinner**

WHAT: The Massachusetts Gaming Commission will hold **public meeting #553** on **Monday, May 5, 2025**.

Once the meeting is called to order, the Commission will review meeting minutes from several past open meetings, including those on January 13, 2023, September 18, 2024, April 3, 2025, and April 10, 2025.

Commissioner Brad Hil will then deliver a legislative update, followed by an administrative update from Executive Director Dean Serpa.

The Sports Wagering Division will then present an update to the official catalog of events and wagers to clarify the Russia/Belarusian prohibition language.

The Community Affairs Division will follow by leading a discussion on the FY26 Community Mitigation Fund.

Commissioner Updates are expected to follow, rounding out the meeting.

At the end of the meeting, there is time reserved for any other business the Chair did not reasonably anticipate at the time of posting.
