WHAT: The Massachusetts Gaming Commission will hold **public meeting #562** on

Thursday, September 4, 2025.

Once the meeting is called to order, the Commission will review minutes from previous Commission meetings.

The Research and Responsible Gaming Division will follow with a presentation of a report titled "Sports Betting Among Young Adults in Massachusetts: preliminary findings."

Plainridge Park Casino will then present its recent quarterly report.

The IEB will then brief Commissioners on two potential noncompliance matters as well as discuss a waiver sought by RSM.

The Sports Wagering Division will present updates to house rules from Caesars, Fanatics, and Penn Sports Interactive. Proposed updates to the approved catalog related to NCAA events will also be discussed.

The Commission is expected to enter into a number of executive sessions on several legal matters, and to approve minutes from previously held executive sessions.

Once back in public session, the Commission will consider regulation amendments. Finally, the racing division will bring forward two items for consideration.

Commissioner Updates are expected to follow, rounding out the meeting.

There is time reserved at the end of the meeting for any other business the Chair did not reasonably anticipate at the time of posting.
