III. Detailed Project Description & Mitigation

While it was anticipated that there would be an obvious increase in call volume to this facility, what was not anticipated was the training aspect. We have many hazards which are associated with this facility and we would like to be sure that our members are optimally trained for emergencies which may occur. To ensure that we have the proper training for this type of structure and contents within, we need to train differently than we would normally have to. High rise firefighting by itself is a unique hazard and involves being highly trained. Also, below grade firefighting can also be considered a unique hazard to this building. As for crowd management emergencies, this building has the highest occupancy load in the city and if an emergency were to occur, it could impact us all in a very negative way without the proper training. Finally, lithium ion battery fires do need to be considered as well due to their destructive nature, especially in parking garages with charging stations. This training will also be helpful twofold as this facility has an energy storage system on property.

2) (If applicable) Please explain how this impact was not anticipated in the Applicant's Host or Surrounding Community Agreement.

The amount of training of many new members may not have been anticipated by EFD when the host agreement was signed. Since that time, we have had a turnover of approximately 30 new members. Many of the senior members were lost due to retirement, injury or death which left us with many new members to train. While these members are very capable, there is much more training that we can provide to ensure this facility receives the best response possible from their fire department. Since opening, EV parking has increased and also, an Energy storage system has been added. Due to these increased hazards, training is vitally important.

3) Please describe what the Applicant is proposing and how the mitigation request will address the impact indicated.

Our proposal is that, if given this grant, then we will be able to proactively train our members for the many special hazards which exist in this facility. Upon completion of this training, our members will have a deeper knowledge of how exactly to handle these unique situations. This will make for a safer environment for all involved, including our department and the facility itself. This will enable us to serve the patrons of this facility on a more advanced level.
