III. Detailed Project Description & Mitigation

1. Since the casino has opened there has been growth in public accessible space along the waterfront. There is a walkway that leads from Encore to the Encore lot at Rivergreen Park, and most recently a boat launch has been added. The department does have a boat but as you move up the Malden river it becomes to shallow for the boats draft. The addition of jet ski's will allow members of the EPD Marine unit to patrol and provide safety to the boating community as well and those that walk along the riverway and pathways along the Malden River in Everett

2. Encore continues to see increases in visitor and the calls for service and numbers of arrests continue to increase. This increase creates a demand/draw on police resources pulling them from other parts of the city to respond.

1. The addition of low drafting water craft (Jet Ski's) along with a trailer to transport will provide officers assigned to the Marine Unit access to areas that the police boat cannot get to without being grounded. This will be a one-time purchase for equipment.

2. Additional funds for overtime will allow us to assign officers specifically dedicated during peak times to support public safety efforts, in and around the casino and areas of interest alongside the casino and across Broadway into. Funding will be to provide 150 additional patrols throughout the year.



