



MGC Non-Notification Equipment List

Purpose

- As per 205 CMR 144.01 (2)(o), the items below are considered Electronic Gaming Devices requiring certification at an MGC licensed independent test lab. Section (o) pertains to devices used in conjunction with electronic gaming devices including bill validators, printers, and other similar devices identified on the commission's website. However, such devices are exempt from the standard Commission approval procedure and do not require notification to the Commission (205 CMR 144.03), as the Commission will allow for the service & replacement of the components listed.

List of devices exempt from Commission approval procedure:

- Bill Validator – Firmware

- Cashbox/Stacker
- Ticket Voucher Printer – Firmware
- Ticket Voucher Printer – Hardware
- PCB Circuit Boards (ex. Cabinet Backplane or Motherboard)

- Mechanical Arm Units
- Video Displays & Monitors
- Touch Screen Displays
- Button Panels
- Card Readers
- Tower Lights
- Audio Components

- Coin Diverters
- Coin Hoppers
- Drop Boxes
