The Massachusetts Gaming Commission to Hold Public Hearing on MGM Springfield's Proposed Design Changes

WHO: The **Massachusetts Gaming Commission** and members of the public

WHAT: The Massachusetts Gaming Commission will host a public hearing as a means to facilitate public discussion regarding MGM Springfield's recently proposed design changes for its resort-casino project in Region B (Western Massachusetts). No votes or decisions will be made at this hearing; it is an opportunity for the Commission to gather information and gauge public sentiment. Individuals will also have an opportunity to sign up to address the Commission on the day of the hearing prior to its start.
