Massachusetts Gaming Commission to Host Weekly Open Meeting

Commissioners Expected to Vote on Matter Regarding Racing Regulatory Reform and a Research Initiative to Aid Host and Surrounding Communities

- WHO: Members of the *Massachusetts Gaming Commission* including Commissioner James McHugh; Commissioner Bruce Stebbins and Commissioner Enrique Zuniga
- **WHAT:** The Massachusetts Gaming Commission (MGC) is hosting its weekly open meeting to discuss the latest gaming news. Commissioners are expected to vote to begin a regulatory reform process presented by MGC's Division of Racing. The racing division is seeking rule changes pertaining to Harness Racing and Horse Racing, which will adopt the nation's best practices presented by the Model Rules of the Racing Commissioners International as they pertain to equine veterinary practices, health and medication. The process that begins tomorrow will include a public hearing and a period for public comment later this winter.

In addition, the commissioners will discuss a possible Inter-Agency Service Agreement with The Edward J. Collins, Jr. Center for Public Management at UMass Boston to execute a research project that will assist Host and Surrounding Communities with assessing the impact for the potential of a large expanded gaming development project.
