Director Vander Linden recommended adding discussion on the transition of the GameSense brand to the March 12, 2026 public meeting. Executive Director Serpa stated that he would provide an update to Commissioner Skinner and Commissioner O’Brien once he and Chief Mills finalized a schedule for future PSAs. He further noted that he would discuss a date for discussion of the involuntary exclusion process with Director Vander Linden.
