## **Agenda Planning for Upcoming Commission Meetings**

(Scheduled Commission Meeting on June 4th)

<u>Item #1 – Administrative Update</u>. Ms. Wells will have an administrative update. There will be a separate Commission meeting on June 11<sup>th</sup> designated for the Commission's approval of the reopening guidelines for the licensees. There will also be an additional agenda item to educate the Commissioners on what the executive offices are recommending at the June 4<sup>th</sup> Commission meeting. Commissioner Zuniga would like to assess the potential for incremental costs of reopening at this meeting as part of this discussion, or at a future discussion.

<u>Item #2 – Regulations</u>. The Horse Racing Committee has requested a potential amendment to 205 CMR 149.04, to develop a new approach to determine the distribution percentage ("split"). The amendment would allow the committee and Commission flexibility to perform the split either by the original method or the proposed additional option, in an effort to distribute funds more precisely. This amendment may be requested for emergency adoption.

<u>Item #3 – Licensee Sexual Harassment Policies Discussion</u>. This item will be ready to present. Staff will conduct 2x2 meetings to brief Commissioners. A document will be recirculated to Commissioners straightaway, and Ms. Banda will confirm with the guest speaker, Maura McLaughlin of Morgan, Brown & Joy.

<u>Item #4 – Budget Discussion – Year 2021</u>. This will be a discussion as to whether or not to vote at the June 18<sup>th</sup> Commission meeting, after receiving public comment. The third meeting on this will be on July 2<sup>nd</sup>. Topics will include new costs such as cleaning and preparations for returning to the office.

<u>Item #5 – MA Cultural Mitigation Program RFP Update</u>. Anita Walker, Executive Director of Mass Cultural Council will update the Commission on the Gaming Mitigation Program and the new Safe Harbors COVID-19 Initiative for Cultural Organizations.

<u>Added item: Horse Racing Opening Status Review and Discussion</u>. The Chair requested an update on preparations for reopening.

<u>Added Item: MGM Qualifier.</u> IEB requests a vote on a completed suitability investigation for a potential MGM Qualifier.

<u>Added Item: PPC License Renewal</u>. Mr. Delaney will provide the Commission with an update on the status of the application, and to discuss PPC's request to adjust the timing of the fee payment (prerequisite for the completed application set by the Commission).
