

Notice of Public Hearing

Notice is hereby provided that in accordance with G.L. c.30A, §2, the Massachusetts Gaming Commission ("Commission") will convene a public hearing for purposes of gathering comments, ideas, and information relative to proposed amendments to 205 CMR. The proposal was developed pursuant to G.L. c.23K, §5, as part of the Commission's regulation promulgation process. The proposal includes the following amendments:

• 205 CMR 138.13: Complimentary Services or Items and Promotional Gaming Credits. This regulation is intended to clarify and aid in the implementation of that provision of G.L. c.23K, § 29 that requires a gaming license to issue to each patron who has been issued a rewards card a monthly statement which shall include the patron's total bets, wins and losses. This regulation covers the provision of notice, the opportunity to opt out, and the corresponding use of technology in the implementation of these requirements.
