Notice of Public Hearing

Notice is hereby provided that in accordance with G.L. c. 30A § 2, the Massachusetts Gaming Commission (“Commission”) will convene a public hearing for purposes of gathering comments, ideas, and information relative to the proposed adoption of **205 CMR 211: Category 1, Category 2, and Category 3 Sports Wagering License Applications; and 205 CMR 240: Adjusted Gross Sports Wagering and Adjusted Gross Fantasy Wagering Receipts Tax Remittance and Reporting**. The proposal was developed pursuant to G.L. c. 23N § 4, as part of the Commission’s regulation promulgation process, and concerns the following regulation:

205 CMR 211: Category 1, Category 2, and Category 3 Sports Wagering License Applications. This regulation outlines the requirements that must be met by an applicant to submit an application for a sports wagering operator license.

205 CMR 240: Adjusted Gross Sports Wagering and Adjusted Gross Fantasy Wagering Receipts Tax Remittance and Reporting. This regulation provides a process for the collection of excise taxes which the Commission is called on to collect relative to sports wagering and fantasy sports.

Scheduled hearing date and time: Tuesday, November 22, 2022, at 9:15 a.m.
