Notice of Public Hearing

Notice is hereby provided that in accordance with G.L. c. 30A § 2, the Massachusetts Gaming Commission (“Commission”) will convene a public hearing for purposes of gathering comments, ideas, and information relative to proposed amendments to 205 CMR. The proposal was developed pursuant to G.L. c. 23K § 5, as part of the Commission’s regulation promulgation process. The proposal includes the following amendments:

205 CMR 134.03: Gaming Service Employees. The proposed amendment would give the Commission discretion to exempt certain gaming service employees from the registration requirement, as determined by its classification of job positions.

205 CMR 138.00: Uniform Standards of Accounting Procedures and Internal Controls. This regulation and the proposed new sections therein, govern the financial and administrative operations of the casinos.

205 CMR 139.04: Reports and Information to Be Filed with the Commission; and

205 CMR 140.02: Computation of Gross Gaming Revenue. These amendments update processes that will generate specific data for the Gross Gaming Revenue Report.

205 CMR 147.05: Gaming Tournaments. This amendment removes this section and incorporates the language into 205 CMR 138.00.

205 CMR 152.00: Individuals Excluded From a Gaming Establishment. The proposed amendments address the process by which an individual will be placed on the Excluded Persons List, and clarify protocol for enforcement.
