## **Notice of Public Hearing**

Notice is hereby provided that in accordance with G.L. c. 30A § 2, the Massachusetts Gaming Commission (“Commission”) will convene a public hearing for purposes of gathering comments, ideas, and information relative to four proposed regulation amendments in 205 CMR. The proposals were developed pursuant to G.L. c. 23K § 5, as part of the Commission’s regulation promulgation process, and concern the following regulations:

**205 CMR 138.02 *Licensee's System of Internal Controls*:** The proposed amendment will establish a timed requirement for licensee’s implementation of a protocol or system of control when deemed necessary by the Executive Director.

**205 CMR 138.05 *Systems for Ensuring Employee Licensing*:** The proposed amendment will restore language that was initially missing from the regulation.

**205 CMR 138.07 *Floor Plans*:** The proposed amendment will establish that the Investigations and Enforcement Bureau is provided with up-to-date floor plans on a quarterly basis.

**205 CMR 138.62 *Payment of Table Game Progressive Payout Wagers*:** The proposed amendment will establish that the Commission be notified of the protocols governing the equal division of progressive jackpots and reset amounts by licensee,
