



NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

October 9, 2013 Meeting

Pursuant to M.G.L. c. 30A, §2, the Massachusetts Gaming Commission (the “Commission”) will hold a public hearing concerning the Commission’s proposed regulation changes to 205 CMR 3.29 and 4.52 primarily governing medication, testing, and associated penalties.

These proposed new rules do several important things for the industry, including finding any occupational licensee found to have administered prohibited substance to a racehorse subject to penalty; preventing the transfer of a horse in a suspended trainer’s care to his or her spouse during the period of suspension; incorporating a schedule of controlled therapeutic medications and associated threshold and treatment restriction windows, and incorporating a “point” penalty scheme assigned to occupational licensees who incur multiple medication violations.


