RULING FORM

Upon receipt of a report from Industrial Laboratories on July 20, 2018 that the blood sample #E272686 taken from the horse Include Gold which finished second in the third race on July 8, 2018 at Suffolk Downs was found to contain Dexamethasone at a level of 12.5 pg/mL, the Suffolk Downs Board of Stewards notified the horse's trainer Keisy Cartagena (DOB [REDACTED] MGC License #139532) of Laurel, MD of her alleged violation of 205 CMR MGC Rules 4:36 (9) and 4:52 (2).

Trainer Keisy Cartagena waived her right to split sample testing and requested a summary hearing before the Suffolk Downs Board of Stewards. A summary hearing was held on on July 31, 2018. The Suffolk Downs Board of Stewards fined Ms. Cartagena the sum of \$500 (five hundred dollars).




The horse Include Gold is hereby disqualified and placed last. The new order of finish is: 1st Whogoosedthemoose, 2nd Doinwhatshelikes, 3rd Rise to the Top, 4th My Awsome Alie, 5th Starship Hostility, 6th Afleet's Dividend, 7th Cowgirl Chick, 8th Main Star, 9th Include Gold.

In accordance with Rule 205, CMR 4:12-(4) all fines shall be paid to the Gaming Commission within forty-eight hours after imposition.

Payment of fines and commencement of suspension may only be Stayed with the express permission of the Chairman of the Massachusetts Gaming Commission.

In accordance with Rule 205, CMR 4.03, an appeal must be filed in writing at the Office of the Gaming Commission within ten days of the date of said ruling.
