Upon receipt of a report from Industrial Labs dated July 24, 2018, that the blood sample # E272633 taken from the horse South Carolina, which won the third race on July 7, 2018 at Suffolk Downs was found to contain Clenbuterol at a level of 357 pg/mL, the Suffolk Downs Board of Stewards notified the trainer of the horse, Timothy M. Collins (DOB (MGC license # 139119), of his alleged violation of 205 CMR rules 4: 36(9) and 4:52.

Having had a summary hearing with Mr. Collins on Tuesday, July 31, 2018, , the Suffolk Downs Board of Stewards hereby suspends the MGC license of Mr. Collins for 7 calendar days, from Monday August 6 through and including Sunday August 12, 2018 and fines Mr. Collins the sum of \$500 (five hundred dollars).

During the period of his suspension, Mr. Collins is denied the privileges of the grounds of Suffolk Downs and all licensed pari-mutuel wagering facilities in Massachusetts; and cannot participate in pari-mutuel horse racing as an owner, trainer, or any other licensee.

The horse South Carolina is hereby disqualified and placed last. The new order of finish is: 1st: Egolyan Son, 2nd Shanghai Storm, 3nd Theresa's Boy, 4th Stormy Forecast, 5th Shakleson, 6th Linns Boy, 7th Compromise, 8th Rockin Eyes, 9th Mr. Chester, 10th South Carolina.

In accordance with Rule 205, CMR 4:12 (4) all fines shall be paid to the Gaming Commission within forty-eight hours after imposition.

Payment of fines and commencement of suspension may only be Stayed with the express permission of the Chairman of the Massachusetts Gaming Commission.

In accordance with Rule 205, CMR 4.03, an appeal must be filed in writing at the Office of the Gaming Commission within ten days of the date of said ruling.
