Upon receipt of a report from Industrial Laboratories on August 28, 2018 that the blood sample #E275376 taken from the horse Front Line Paige which finished first in the eleventh race on August 4, 2018 at Suffolk Downs was found to contain Glycopyrrolate at a level of 23 +/- .03 pg/mL, the Suffolk Downs Board of Stewards notified the horse's trainer Neil R. Morris (DOB [REDACTED] MGC License #139499) of Middleburg VA of his alleged violation of 205 CMR MGC Rules 4:35 (10,11), 4:36 (9) and 4:52 (1)(2). Mr. Morris also requested a split sample, which was confirmed by the AFTL laboratory on October 22, 2018 at a level of 20.5 +/- 2.1 pg/mL.

Trainer Neil Morris requested a summary hearing before the Suffolk Downs Board of Stewards which was held on November 2, 2018. The Suffolk Downs Board of Stewards fined Mr. Morris the sum of \$500 (five hundred dollars).


The horse Front Line Paige is hereby disqualified and placed last. The new order of finish is: 1st Trilogy; 2nd Gold Braid; 3rd Freekson; 4th Front Line Paige.


In accordance with Rule 205, CMR 4:12 (4) all fines shall be paid to the Gaming Commission within forty-eight hours after imposition.


Payment of fines and commencement of suspension may only be Stayed with the express permission of the Chairman of the Massachusetts Gaming Commission.
