Having held a summary hearing on August 17, 2018 concerning the claim of the horse Avicii from the twelfth race at Suffolk Downs on August 4, 2018, the Suffolk Downs Board of Stewards has fined trainer David Nunn (DOB [REDACTED] MGC License # 137969) the sum of \$3,000.00 (three thousand dollars) and suspended him for a period of 30 days (from August 23, 2018 to and including September 21, 2018) for the planning and execution of improper claims, a violation of rule 205 CMR 4:06 (1). Mr. Nunn admitted to enlisting three individuals and providing each participant with the appropriate funds to claim the horse Avicii, which he himself owned and trained.


In accordance with Rule 205 CMR:4:12 (4) all fines shall be paid to the Gaming Commission within forty-eight hours after imposition.


Payment of fines and commencement of suspension may only be stayed with the express permission of the Chairman of the Massachusetts Gaming Commission.

In accordance with Rule 205 CMR 4:03, an appeal must be filed in writing at the Office of the Gaming Commission within ten days of the date of said ruling.
