Upon receipt of a report from Industrial Laboratories on May 22, 2019, that the blood sample #E319646 taken from the horse Mr. Stream, who finished eighth in the sixth race on May 18, 2019 was found to contain Aminocaproic Acid at a level of 8.83 ug/mL, the Suffolk Downs Board of Stewards notified the trainer Rafael Ramos (DOB [REDACTED] MGC License # 140311) of his alleged violation of 205 MGC Rules 4:35 (10,11) 4.36 (9) and 4:52 (1,2). Mr. Ramos declined a split sample.

Trainer Rafael Ramos requested a summary hearing before the Suffolk Downs Board of Stewards which was held on June 29, 2019. The Suffolk Downs Board of Stewards fined Mr. Ramos the sum of \$1,000 (one thousand dollars).


The horse Mr. Stream is hereby disqualified and placed last. The new order of finish is: 1st Bret's at Caddies, 2nd Creaky Cricket, 3rd The Zip Zip Man, 4th Giant Trick, 5th Trooping the Color, 6th Indian Bucks, 7th Springers Point, 8th Victory Slide, **9th Mr. Stream.

In accordance with Rule 205, CMR 4:12 (4) all fines shall be paid to the Gaming Commission within forty-eight hours after imposition.

Payment of fines and commencement of suspension may only be stayed with the express permission of the Chairman of the Massachusetts Gaming Commission.

In accordance with Rule 205, CMR 4.03, an appeal must be filed in writing at the office of the Gaming Commission within ten days of said ruling.
