



## Voluntary Self-Exclusion Options in the Everett and Surrounding Area

Voluntary self-exclusion allows individuals to exclude themselves from the gaming floor in all casinos and pari-mutuel facilities in Massachusetts.

Self-exclusions are offered without an appointment at all casinos in Massachusetts, at select locations with an appointment, and drop-in hours in Somerville for a limited time.

### Drop-In Times:

Drop-in self-exclusions can be done on any casino property in Massachusetts. Additionally, drop-in hours are also available from mid-June to early July in Somerville (31 Union Square) via the GameSense program during the following dates/times:

**June 13:** 3pm-5pm

**June 19:** 11am-2pm

**June 14:** 10am-1pm

**June 24 to July 8:** 9am-12pm

**June 18:** 11am-2pm
